

Class of 2014 earns \$5.2 million in college scholarships and grants

As of May 14, 2014, the 89 graduates of the Class of 2014 at Washington Math Science Technology (WMST) Public Charter High School had earned \$5,256,942 in four-year scholarships, grants, and other non-loan financial aid. Congratulations to the Class of 2014, their families and to WMST's Counseling Department.

Included in this calculation are the following awards: Pell Grant, DC-TAG, the DC-CAP Last Dollar Award, university grants, university scholarships, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants, work-study, local scholarships, Hi/SCIP and Dual Enrollment Scholarships, including one at Corcoran College of Art + Design and two at the University of the District of Columbia.

Many Class of 2014 members would be the first in their families to earn a four-year college degree.
