

WMST registers highest growth in 10th Grade Mathematics scores among DC charters in 2012

According to the DC Public Charter School Board (DCPCSB), Washington Math Science Technology Public Charter High School (WMST PCHS) registered the highest growth in 10th grade Mathematics scores on DC CAS in 2012, [DCPCSB officials announced on Nov. 7](#). DC CAS is a [standardized Math and Reading Comprehension test](#) that DC public school and public charter school students take in Grades 3-8 and 10 each year.

Along with DC Mayor Vincent Gray and his educational team, DCPCSB released on Nov. 7 a 2012 Performance Management Framework (PMF), a tool for monitoring and assessing DC public charter school performance.

According to the 2012 PMF, WMST PCHS is a Tier 2 school (out of three tiers), which means that the school meets minimum performance goals but falls short of meeting the highest standards. There are 64 public charter schools in Washington, D.C., and 20 were ranked as Tier 1, with an additional 35 in Tier 2.
