

Three Summer programs begin on June 25

On Monday June 25, three summer programs for incoming and returning students will begin at Washington Math Science Technology Public Charter High School (WMST PCHS).

All students should report to the upper level multi-purpose room by 8:30 a.m. All programs will begin on the same date; however, the date that each program will end will vary.

In addition, parents and guardians should also complete lunch, residency and other required forms immediately for the 2012-2013 school year.

At WMST, we are offering three summer programs:

1. **CREDIT RECOVERY:** for 9th , 10th and 11th graders who are **current WMST students** (only students who attended WMST this past school year) and who have failed one or two classes and need to take it (them) over for credit (**Six weeks ending August 3rd**)
2. **SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM:** for incoming 9th graders (**Four weeks ending July 20th**)
3. **DC CAS PREPARATION (Reading and Math):** for rising 10th graders (new and returning students) (**Six weeks ending August 3rd**)

If you have been assigned a Summer Youth Employment Program job site other than WMST, you must contact Dr. N'Deye Diagne at 202-636-8011 and the Summer Youth Employment Program office to request WMST as your work site.

Also, please be advised that during the duration of the summer program, WMST will provide breakfast each morning from 8 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Lunch will also be provided daily.
